



NORD ALLEY CONSTRUCTION - WHAT'S HAPPENING?

Seattle City Light is excavating and replacing an aging underground conduit (duct bank) along Nord Alley. The work will increase electrical reliability. Later in the fall, the Seattle Department of Transportation will repave the alley with a Pioneer Square Preservation Board-approved brick pattern.

 MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY 9A-3P & 6P-10P
 ACCESS TO NORD ALLEY BUSINESS
FROM S MAIN STREET ONLY
 (LIMITED GARAGE ACCESS)

PHASE 2
 SATURDAY / SUNDAY 9A-5P
 NO ACCESS TO NORD ALLEY BUSINESS
 LIMITED ACCESS FROM S JACKSON ST
 NO THRU ACCESS
WEEKENDS THROUGH JULY 2016

PHASE 3
 MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY 9A-3P & 6P-10P
 ACCESS TO NORD ALLEY BUSINESS
FROM S JACKSON STREET ONLY
 NO THRU ACCESS
WEEKDAYS THROUGH AUGUST 2016



Customers should expect noise caused by construction equipment during work hours.

- Access to Nord Alley will be limited during construction. One side of the alley at a time will be partially blocked or closed. Access to businesses will remain open during construction. The work will proceed from south to north.
- No power or telecommunications outages are expected.
- Trash/recycling disposal locations may shift to designated areas in the alley.
