



WHAT IS THE DENNY SUBSTATION PROJECT?



▲ *The Denny Substation will serve expanding companies and institutions and benefit people within and beyond the project area*

PROJECT ELEMENTS:

- A new electrical substation – Seattle City Light’s largest first in 30 years – at Denny Way and Stewart Street
- An underground distribution network to serve South Lake Union and the Denny Triangle
- A future transmission line to carry power to the substation

WHY A NEW SUBSTATION?

- Seattle is growing, especially in the South Lake Union and Denny Triangle neighborhoods:
 - 11,000 new housing units
 - 30,000 new jobs
- The City is making significant investments in transit, street and parks in order to keep pace with growth
- Building the substation will provide the electrical infrastructure required to meet the power needs of current and anticipated consumers
