For Commenting at the SEPA Scoping Meetings

Your comments can help Seattle City Light decide

- which alternatives to evaluate in the EIS
- the analysis of likely impacts those alternatives might have

Please join us here between 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. tonight to provide your comments on these topics:

- The preliminary alternatives proposed by City Light, which we would compare to a No Build Alternative in the EIS
- The areas of impact we plan to analyze, any specific concerns you may have about those topic areas, or requests for specific types of analysis related to possible environmental impacts
- The types of mitigation measures that could be evaluated within the EIS for any identified probable significant adverse impacts

- **If you would like to present oral comments**, please sign-in on the sign-up sheets near the entry to the meeting room. Names will be called in the order received. When your name is called, please proceed to the microphone to present your comments so that they can be recorded.
- **Equal weight will be given** to all oral and written comments regarding the scope of the EIS. It is not necessary to repeat comments already offered by other speakers.

- **All oral comments presented** at the EIS Scoping meetings will be recorded by the court reporter and a transcript of comments will be produced.
- **When presenting comments**, please provide your name and address so that the court reporter has an accurate record.

- **A time limit on the length** of oral comments will be adhered to ensure everyone has an opportunity to provide comments. The meeting facilitator may need to limit the time allowed for each comment depending on the number of people who sign up to comment. Please assume time will be limited to 3 minutes for each speaker and additional time may be allowed.

- **Silence your cell phone's ringer** and please do not use your cell phone in the meeting room.
