If an existing overhead distribution system is converted to underground as part of a voluntary Underground Project (VUP), private property owners are responsible to pay for and make arrangements with contractors and service providers to convert their existing overhead service to underground. These private property conversions must be installed, inspected and ready for connection at the time that Seattle City Light energizes the new underground system. 100% of property owners in the proposed underground conversion area must sign this form. This form is to be completed by property owners. It is not contractually binding but will serve as the basis for subsequent stages of the VUP process and ultimately for a final binding contractual agreement executed prior to construction.. As the VUP Process advances, this form will be updated in the Preliminary Engineering Stage and the Final Engineering Stage. Note that SCL has no control over non-SCL costs and the "Estimated Non-SCL Cost" are non-binding and provided only as a conceptual aid to help individuals understand potential total costs.
