

Push-To-Fit Earplugs



1. Scope

This standard covers the requirements for push-to-fit corded earplugs.

This standard applies to Seattle City Light (SCL) Stock No. 013941.

2. Application

Push-to-fit earplugs are used to reduce noise and conserve hearing. They come with a flexible stem that eliminates the need to roll the earplugs before inserting them.

Push-to-fit earplugs are designed to fit most ears; however, other styles are available that may provide a better fit. Please see a Safety and Health Specialist for assistance.

3. Requirements

Each earplug shall protect hearing up to 29 dB and be constructed as follows:

- Yellow vinyl neck cord
- Polyurethane foam
- Stem for push-to-fit foam insertion

4. Packaging

Push-to-fit earplugs shall be individually packaged and legibly marked with the following information:

- Manufacturer's identification
- Product description
- Seattle City Light stock number

Product shall be packaged 100 individual packages per box.

Each shipping container shall be legibly marked with the following information:

- Manufacturer's identification
- Country of origin
- Product description
- Seattle City Light purchase order number

5. Issuance
