




## PRODUCT CONTENT LABEL <sup>[1]</sup>

Green Up is sold in blocks of 200, 400 or 800 kilowatt-hours (kWh). This chart provides the Green Up projected renewable resource product mix in 2016.

### Green-e Energy Eligible New<sup>[2]</sup> Renewables in Green Up



1. Prospective figures reflect the renewables that we have contracted to provide. Actual figures may vary according to resource availability. We will annually report to you before August 1 of next year in the form of a Historical Product Content Label the actual resource mix of the electricity you purchased.

2. New Renewables come from generation facilities that first began commercial operation within the past 15 years.

3. Eligible hydroelectric facilities are defined in the Green-e Energy National Standard (<http://www.green-e.org/standard>) and include facilities certified by the Low Impact Hydropower Institute (LIHI) ([www.lowimpacthydro.org](http://www.lowimpacthydro.org)); and facilities comprised of a turbine in a pipeline or a turbine in an irrigation canal.

For comparison, the current average mix of resources supplying Seattle City Light includes: Hydroelectric 89.6%, Nuclear\*\* 4.3%, Wind 3.6 %, Coal\*\* 0.9%, Others\* 0.9%, Landfill Gas 0.7%. Source: This information is provided in compliance with fuel disclosure provisions of the Fuel Mix Disclosure section of RCW 19.29A, passed by the Washington State Legislature in 2000 and based on 2014 data.

\*\*These fuels represent a portion of the power from BPA. \*Others include Biomass, Natural Gas, Petroleum, Waste and Non-specified Purchases.

How will I be billed?	Your bimonthly Seattle City Light bill will include the total of two monthly charges for Green Up. Your monthly bill will include charges for one month.
How will my bill be calculated?	Charges are calculated on your purchases as follows: 200 kWh = \$3.00/month   400 kWh = \$6.00/month   800 kWh = \$12.00/month The Green Up purchase is in addition to regular electricity charges from Seattle City Light. Your enrollment level will be specified in your Customer Welcome Packet.
Will by Green Power rates change over time?	Green Up rates are subject to review and revision, but have not changed since the program's inception in 2005.
Is there a Green Up termination fee?	There are no early termination fees assessed on your account.
How long have I agreed to participate in Green Up?	There is no contract requirement. You may stop participating in the program at any time.
What other fees might I be charged?	No additional fees are assessed to Green Up customers. However, a \$10 late fee is charged to utility accounts that are 15 days past due.
