

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

CITY OF SEATTLE, SEATTLE CITY LIGHT DEPARTMENT

Pursuant to Seattle Municipal Code, Chapter 3.02, dealing with the Administrative Code, the City of Seattle, Seattle City Light Department, hereinafter referred to as the “Department,” proposes to amend its Department Policy and Procedure Manual. A synopsis of the proposed amendment follows:

The Department proposes to revise the following policies and their related cost schedules:

**1. Department Policy and Procedure DPP 500 P III-417, Schedule 100
Installation and Removal Charges for Permanent Services**

This policy establishes charges for permanent service installation and/or removal of Looped Radial & Network.

REVISION: Update labor and material costs and in section 2.7, and includes new Amp Fee Installation charge.

**2. Department Policy and Procedure DPP 500 P III-417, Schedule 101
Installation Charges for Temporary Services for Construction**

This policy establishes installation charge for temporary services for construction power which appear in this schedule shall apply to service rated up to 225 amperes, single-phase, 120/240 volts in looped radial areas. In network areas, charges for temporary installations will be determined on an individual basis.

REVISION: Update labor and material costs and includes new Amp Fee Installation charge.

**3. Department Policy and Procedure DPP 500 P III-417, Schedule 102
Service Poles and Anchors on Private Property**

This policy establishes the department policy regarding service poles and anchors on private property in accordance with the Service Pole section of the Requirements for Electrical Service Connection.

REVISION: Update labor and material costs and revised text in sections 2.1.3 “Setting” and 2.2.3 “anchor and one guy”

**4. Department Policy and Procedure DPP 500 P III-422, Schedule 100
Final Connection Costs for Permanent or Enlarged Services Installed by
Contractors**

This policy established payment for final connection costs incurred by the Department in energizing permanent or enlarged services installed by contractors employed by customers.

REVISION: Update labor and material costs in sections 2.4 and 2.5, and includes new Amp Fee Installation charge.

**5. Department Policy and Procedure DPP 500 P III-422, Schedule 101
Final Connection Costs for Temporary Services for Construction Installed by
Contractors**

This policy establishes payment for final connection, disconnection, and removal costs incurred by the Department in energizing and de-energizing temporary services installed by contractors employed by customers.

REVISION: Update labor and material costs, and includes new Amp Fee Installation charge.
