

FREE Climate Change Education Programs for 2008-2009!



1. Sign Up for the SHRINKING BIGFOOT ASSEMBLY

This live assembly show for 3rd-5th grades will ignite school-wide interest by taking students on a fun and interactive adventure to learn about climate change, what causes it, and how each person can be part of the solution. Teachers will receive a discussion and activity guide tied to the assembly prior to its presentation.

The assembly is available selected weeks between November 2008 and February 2009. Program is limited and scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis. Elementary schools in the Seattle City Light service area with a minimum of 75 students in 3rd-5th grades are eligible.

2. Schedule WORKSHOPS for 4th & 5th Grade Classrooms

The 4th and 5th grade classroom workshop will build on climate change concepts learned in the assembly by providing in depth discussion partnered with hands-on activities. Students will learn how their choices can increase or decrease their carbon footprints. The workshop is aligned with GLEs (Grade Level Expectations).

Workshops can be scheduled for two or more 4th/5th grade classrooms per school throughout the school year, with or without the assembly.

3. Attend a TEACHER TRAINING

This teacher training will provide 4th and 5th grade teachers with background knowledge about climate change, lesson extension ideas, and follow-up resources that demonstrate how to incorporate this topic into curriculum. Two teacher trainings will be scheduled this school year.

A \$50 stipend will be offered upon completion of workshop objectives.
