- SDOT will present information on changes they're making to signal timing along Mercer; connecting the new Westlake Protected Bike Lane to the neighborhood and downtown along 9th Ave N to 7th Ave and Bell Street; upgrading bus service to the University District; extending the SLU Streetcar line to downtown; managing on-street parking and loading; and replacing the last timber-supported bridge in Seattle, the Fairview Ave N Bridge
- The Office of Planning and Community Development will explain its Open Space Plan
- City Light will explain its Advanced Metering program and the construction impacts of the Denny Substation Project
- Seattle Public Utilities will have information about recycling and food waste collection for apartment residents
- The Office of Housing will explain various affordable housing programs, including Mandatory Housing Affordability
- There will be information about the city's Democracy Voucher program
