1. Schedule F is available to all customers, including but not limited to water and sewer districts and King County, who contract with the Department for floodlights operating from dusk to dawn.
2. Schedules T and L are available to all customers, including but not limited to water and sewer districts and King County, who contract with the Department for dusk-to-dawn lighting of streets, alleys, and other public thoroughfares.
3. Schedule P is available to all customers, including but not limited to water and sewer districts and King County, who contract with the Department for pedestrian lighting.
