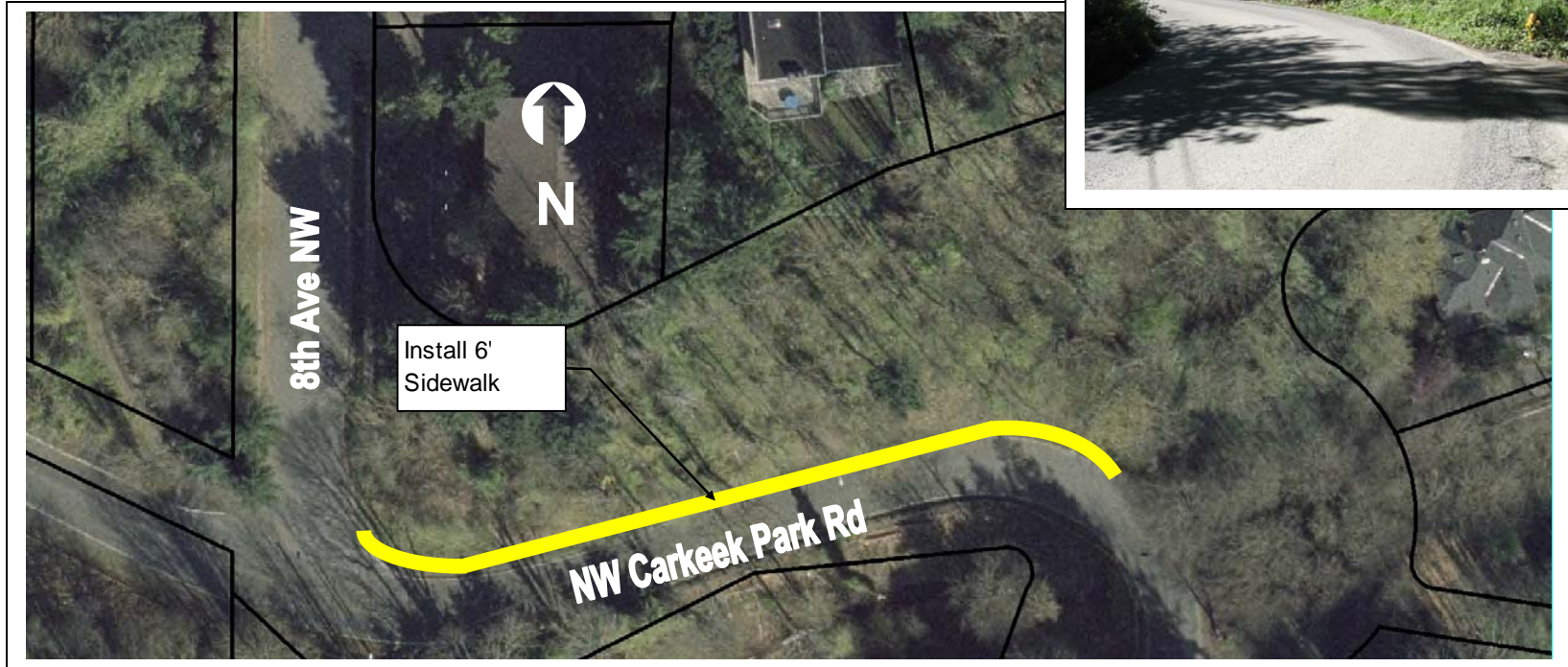




Carkeek Park Road – 798 Carkeek Park Rd to 8th Avenue NW

Applicant Description of Problem and/or Project:

Problem: There is a public access path from 113th down to Carkeek Park Road. It was put in so people can get off the bus on 3rd Avenue and walk to the park safely. The problem is that where the path ends at 798 Carkeek Park Road, the north side of the road heading towards the park has in the past been maintained by SDOT. But in the last 3 years it has been let go until I call or there is a special event in the park. This is a very dangerous place for people to walk and I have almost been hit by a car several times.

Suggested Project: The path needs to be cleared and have crushed rock put down and maintained or a sidewalk put in.

Potential Solution and/or Comments:

North side of Carkeek Park Road from 798 Carkeek Park Rd to 8th Avenue NW

- Construct 6-foot concrete sidewalk on North side of Carkeek Park Road for approximately 350 feet on the north side of the street.

Challenges/Tradeoffs:

- Curbs not feasible due to lack of drainage infrastructure.
- The sidewalk setback and grade will be per the City's standards to accommodate the construction of a curb and gutter if desired by a future project.

Preliminary Range of Cost: \$ 120,000 to \$ 160,000
