Applicant Description of Problem and/or Project:

Problem: The side walks are badly degraded or non-existent. Pedestrian access to Dearborn Elementary School is dangerous, especially when it is non-daylight hours. If the improvements are made, many will walk safely from Beacon Ave South to Lake Washington.

Suggested Project: Install and/or repair sidewalks and add lighting.

Potential Solution and/or Comments:

South Orcas Street – Beacon Avenue South to Martin Luther King Way South

- Replace 20 percent of existing 5-foot concrete sidewalk on the north side of the street.
- Upgrade all existing luminaries on the north side of the street.
- Add a new luminaire at the following intersections: 26th Ave S, 32nd Ave S, 33rd Ave S, and 35th Ave S.

Challenges/Tradeoffs:

- Luminaire upgrade and installation of new luminaries will have to be coordinated with Seattle City Light.

Preliminary Range of Cost: \$300,000 to \$380,000
