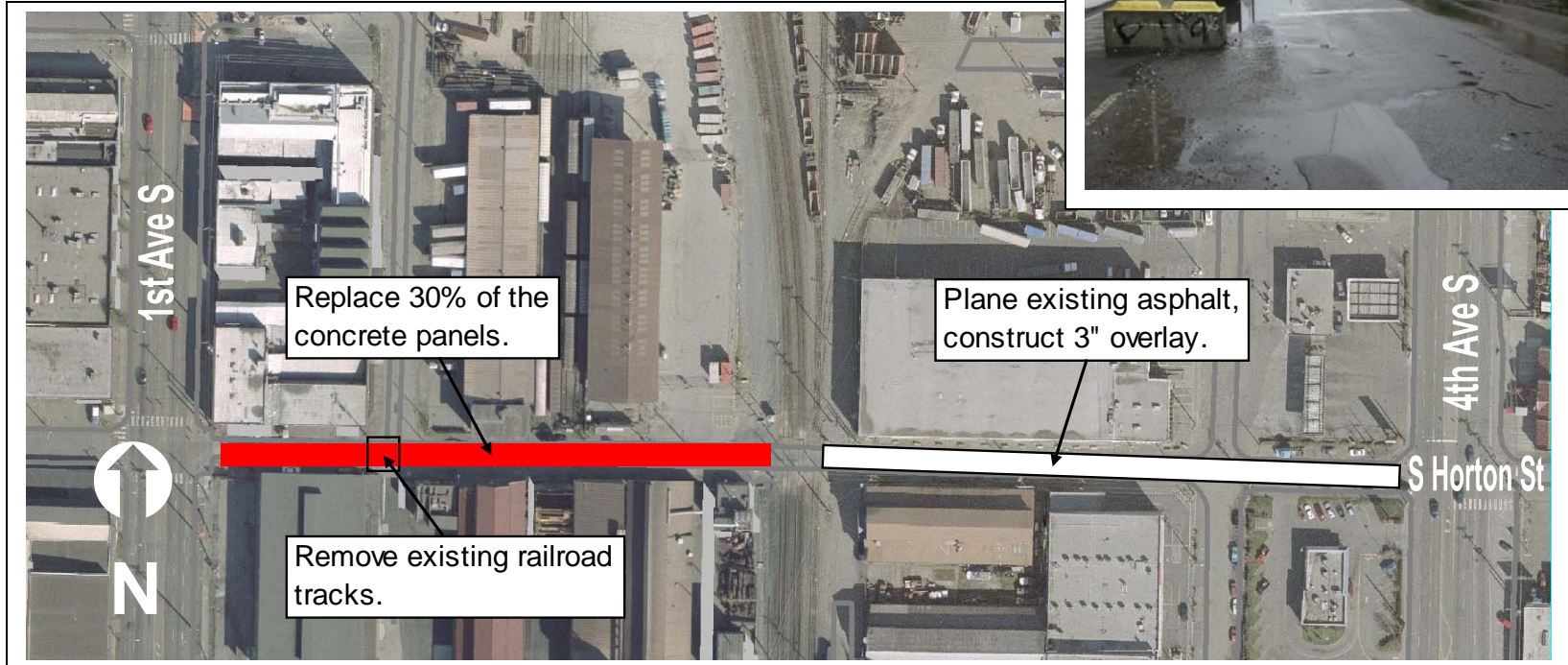

Applicant Description of Problem and/or Project:

Problem: Limited east-west connectors w/in the Greater Duwamish MIC.

Suggested Project: S Horton from 4th to 1st Ave S needs to be repaired and repaved with special attention to the unused rails just east of 1st Ave S.

Potential Solution and/or Comments:

S Horton Street – 4th Avenue S to 1st Avenue S

- Plane existing asphalt from 1st Ave S to the railroad tracks on the east end of the project.
- Construct a 3" overlay with asphalt pavement from 1st Ave S to the railroad tracks.
- Remove existing railroad crossing that is no longer active.
- Remove and replace failing concrete panels from railroad tracks to 4th Avenue S at the west end of the project.

Challenges/Tradeoffs:

- Need to confirm that the railroad tracks proposed for removal are inactive.

Preliminary Range of Cost: \$ 320,000 to \$ 400,000
