Applicant Description of Problem and/or Project:

Problem: Highest Priorities

- 1) S. Findlay St between 39th Ave S and 42nd Ave S
- 2) S Mead St between 46th Ave S and 48th Ave S
- 3) 46th Ave S between S Orcas St and S Juneau St.

Suggested Project: We propose building new curbs and sidewalks on those streets and blocks that have neither. On other blocks where adequate sidewalks are provided, but without the accompanying curbs, we propose building new curbs. Hillman City Neighborhood Alliance members are currently obtaining signatures of support for the project from the residents of Hillman City.

Potential Solution and/or Comments:

S. Findlay St. between 39TH Ave. S and 42nd Ave. S

- Construct concrete curb, gutter, 5-foot planting strip and 6-foot concrete sidewalk for approximately 650 feet along the south side of the street.
- Construct new catch basins and storm sewer to collect street runoff.

S. Mead St. between 46th Ave S and 48th Ave S and 46th Ave S between S Orcas St and S Juneau St.

- Construct concrete curb, gutter along both sides of the street.
- Construct new catch basins and storm sewer to collect street runoff.

Challenges/Tradeoffs:

- The addition of the curb and gutter may eliminate street parking along all improved streets.

Preliminary Range of Cost: \$ 1,520,000 to \$ 1,860,000
