The Robert C. Smith Building is just to the east of the main entrance off of 16<sup>th</sup>. Park in visitor parking at main looped entry drive on West Side of building and - enter through breezeway into building courtyard. The Presidents office suite is directly to the left.

As was discussed throughout the Master Plan process, South Seattle Community College will be undertaking a feasibility analysis before making any decisions regarding possible construction of a residence hall on campus. Specifically, the CAC report" included recommendations to require a formal evaluation process (feasibility study) prior to any decision to construct student housing on campus including CAC evaluation of the scope of the feasibility analysis and opportunity for both the CAC and general public to provide comments prior to submission of any MUP application for the student housing development."

South Seattle Community College has hired a consultant team (MGT of America, Inc.) to help them undertake this analysis. The College has scheduled a time to both solicit feedback from the CAC on the proposed scope of work for the residence hall feasibility study, and to have an opportunity to meet with the consultant team to discuss what the CAC and community sees as "opportunities and concerns" concerning this potential project.
