‘Passport Day in the USA’ event to be held
in four local Neighborhood Service Centers in Seattle

SEATTLE – The City of Seattle’s Department of Neighborhoods is hosting a Passport Fair in four Neighborhood Service Centers on Saturday, March 28, 2009 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. to provide passport information to U.S. citizens and to accept passport applications. The City of Seattle is joining the Department of State in celebrating “Passport Day in the USA,” a national passport acceptance and outreach event.

On June 1, 2009, U.S. citizens must present a passport book, passport card, or other travel documents approved by the U.S. government to enter the United States from Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean and Bermuda at land borders and sea ports of entry.
