- Park access hours may vary; contact 206-684-4075 for schedule.
- Valid through December.
- Non-refundable, non-transferable.
- Parked vehicles with trailers must display launching permit on dashboard.

Additional Conditions for Overnight Use

- Overnight parking is not allowed without valid overnight permit.
- Four consecutive night maximum.
- Park entrance may be locked at night.
