

Welcome to Queen Anne Community Center

As you may have heard in recent months, the City of Seattle faced a 2011 budget shortfall of \$67 million. This meant serious budget reductions in almost every City department, including Parks and Recreation.

One result of those reductions affects Queen Anne Community Center by reducing its weekly operating hours to 30 hours in 2011. It is now known as a "limited use center."

**Beginning January 3, 2011, the center will be open:
Monday-Thursday, 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
Friday, 1 to 8 p.m.**

We are pleased to be able to keep the center open for you; however, the reductions also mean significantly limited staffing. Programs operated by the Associated Recreation Council (child care, summer day camps, and preschools) will continue. Parks staff will be available only during operating hours to accept payments and registrations. Magnolia Community Center at (206) 386-4235 can also assist you with payments and registration during their operating hours.

Outside of Queen Anne Community Center's operating hours, the building will still be available for rentals and some programs requiring registration. If you have an event scheduled and cannot get in, please call the Park Duty Officer at 206-982-4583.
