- Project Description: The budget provides \$2,000,000 for design, permitting, and construction. Improvements may include repairs to existing breakwater structures, replacement of floating moorages, and ADA accessibility. Renovations are limited to in-water portions of the moorages only – does not included up-land work such as parking or restroom facilities. Current funding will not cover all needed repairs at all of the moorages. The intent of the schematic design phase is to prioritize repairs for the first phase of construction, and identify all needed repairs to pursue additional funding.
