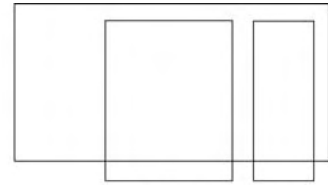
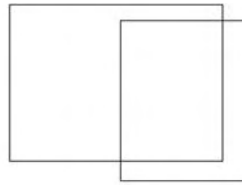

1.1	Community Meeting Review Stephen Antupit reviewed the results of Community Meeting #1: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In general, meeting attendees provided positive reviews of the community meeting process. - Mithun will compile the results of the community meeting and visioning results in a report that will be provided to Parks at the end of this visioning phase of work. - The 'where you live' and 'where you hang' map indicates that Mall employees did not attend the meeting. - Approximately 40% of the attendees represented the elderly community. A number of these were from the Senior Housing high-rise building on 8th Avenue. - The Cultural Audit, in progress, will provide input from people who were not at the meeting. (Laura Curry, who is

	<p>conducting the Cultural Audit, was at the Community Meeting.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Station Image Boards and passport results were reviewed. Images were color-coded with 5 categories (warm/positive to cool/less positive) representing the range of response found in the passports. - Mithun provided a 'commonalities summary' (attached) describing image ranking and written comments indicated on the passports, as well as preliminary Cultural Audit impressions. - Guiding Principles' (attached) were derived from the 'commonalities summary'. These were then used for the ranking exercise (see below). 	
1.2	<p>Stephen led the PAT through a ranking exercise, using a list of qualities and elements that were derived from the community meeting results. The PAT voted for each item against the other items until every item had been compared with the other items on the list. Results of this exercise are attached.</p> <p>Kim Baldwin asked PAT members to 'wear their community representative hats' while voting, and noted that these results, taken with the overall community outreach and cultural audit process, will help Seattle Parks and Recreation to determine a final program for the Park. Stephen Antupit clarified that the final combination and space allocations of program elements may remain vague during concept designs and that the community will review and comment on concept options in the process of refining the program.</p>	Mithun to compile results for final report. Interim results are attached to these minutes.
1.3	<p>As the ranking exercise took longer than anticipated, the meeting ended at that point, and Kim Baldwin provided a 'homework' item to the PAT members via email.</p>
