- Boulders, possibly real
- Like explorer dome
- New structures are not as interesting
- Like existing Roxhill layout plus imagination
- Like covered slide
- Don't like generic features of new play equipment in general
- Explorer dome is well received
- Leathers proposal is well liked-flowing structure tag-hide and seek
- One year old can play on existing castle park
- \*Combine big and little kid designs. Keep Combined
- Look at Hiawatha, Large Rocks, Real and logs
- Don't lose all elements for larger kids, Track Slide is good
- Put sand box back in-Good for parents if you want to rest-creative tactile, Sharing
- Tree is currently being kept - good
- Community build, community outreach – someone will reach out for volunteers in order to make Leather's work within budget
- Don't lose the variety by seeking to get one specific structure, like what the other smaller elements provide
- Don't lose character of the existing structure
- Eight year old child in attendance favors **Playcraft** castle plus imaginative (two structures allows for home vs. invader play)

Construction: April 2012 – September 2012
