This Bilateral Amendment #5 is entered into by Comsys Services LLC (“Vendor”) and the City of Seattle (the “City”). This Amendment #5 to the Agreement between The City of Seattle and Comsys Services LLC for Information Technology Services, Staff Augmentation Agreement is effective on the date of the last signature of the parties (“Effective Date”).

WHEREAS, the original agreement between the parties specified that an agreement may be modified from time to time by mutual agreement;

WHEREAS, the original agreement allows for a term extension through September 30, 2009.

WHEREAS, the City is prepared to extend the current Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Agreement is Amended as follows;

1. The scope of Amendment #5 includes the addition of a Survivorship clause;

Survivorship


All scopes of work, transactions and deliverables executed pursuant to the authority of this Contract shall be bound by all of the terms, conditions, prices and price discounts set forth herein, notwithstanding the expiration of the final term of this Contract. Further, the terms, conditions and warranties contained in this Contract that by their sense and context are intended to survive the completion of the performance, expiration, cancellation or termination of this Contract shall so survive.”


2. The term of the Agreement is extended for a period of 9 months starting January 1, 2009 and ending September 30, 2009.
3. In all other respects this Agreement remains unchanged.
