SCOPE:

The City of Seattle has had successful vehicle maintenance and repair services contract with a local provider; however that contract now expires and does not have any renewal options. Therefore, the City is returning for a competitive bid to establish one or more contracts for these services. The City wishes to establish one or more five year contracts with an option to extend for an additional two years with the lowest responsive, responsible bidder(s).

The City's estimated annual usage for this vehicle routine and non-routine preventative maintenance, repair services, emergency servicing and other related services is \$60,000.00. The City currently has approximately 70 vehicles ranging from the mid 1990's to 2005 foreign and domestic fleet. The vehicle average mileage is 119,000 miles.

In general, The City vehicle(s) will be delivered to the Vendor's shop on an appointment basis. The Authorized City representative will deliver the vehicle(s) to the Vendor's facility; provide a description of problem areas and the key to the vehicle(s).
