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- II. State Agencies: Submit Order directly to Contractor for processing. Political Subdivisions: Submit orders directly to Contractor referencing State of Washington Contract No. 01102. If you are unsure of your status in the State Purchasing Cooperative call (360) 902-7415.

- III. Only authorized purchasers included on the State Purchasing Cooperative (SPC) listing published and updated periodically by OSP may purchase from this contract. It is the contractor's responsibility to verify membership of Political Subdivisions/Non-Profit Corporations in the SPC prior to processing orders received under this contract. Contractors shall not process state contract orders from unauthorized purchasers.

Special Conditions:

1. This Current Contract Information (Change Notice No. 6) administratively changes the company name of contractor from: Ben-Ko-Matic Company; change to: Owen Equipment Company. Additionnaly this change notice revises prices for the Owen Equipment Company. Revised company information and prices are listed under Group 11F and 11G of the contract price pages. All other terms, conditions, and pricing remain unchanged.

2. The contract is to provide convenient cost effective suppliers (those identified under Attachment "B") for rental of medium and heavy duty type construction equipment on an as needed/as-available basis (without operator) throught the State of Washington.

3. **Insurance Certificate**

Insurance Certificate per requirements of Section II, Paragraph 6B, General Requirements; Contractors will forward to the State Procurement Officer within fifteen (15) calendar days of receipt Notice of Award, evidence in the form of a Certificate of

Insurance (attached) satisfactory to the Sate that insurance has been secured. Failure to provide proof of insurance as required will result in contract cancellation.

Each user agency will have the option of utilizing the equipment contractor(s) in their city or closest city whom best meet the needs of that particular agency; based upon cost, availability, and type of equipment available.

This contract will be for equipment with and without delivery and pick-up. See Contract Pricing above for applicable option.

All rentals under this contract will be placed, by the using agency, directly with the contractor at the point of pick-up.

8. Equipment Rentals Not Listed on Contract 01102

Equipment rentals not listed on Contract 01102 and exceeding General Authority limit, will require state agency preparation and submission of A-15, Purchase Acquisition to OSP.

Maintenance

- A. The contractor, prior to rental of equipment, shall be responsible for furnishing all maintenance and services, such as lubrication, servicing, licenses and registration fees, and other operational expenses, parts and supplies, and in so doing, shall not require the state to defray any of these expenses. The state rents the equipment at the rates specified herein; entered by the vendor in the column of the rental rates for the area and type of equipment. The rates set forth herein are exclusive of the cost of fuel (Turn-in "Top Off"). Minor lubrication servicing and repairs to long term rentals will be the responsibility of the customer.
- B. All major repairs due to breakdown while equipment is in a rental status will be the responsibility of the contractor unless breakdown is the direct result of customer negligence.
- C. The contractor will provide a Full Fuel Tank at the time the equipment is accepted by the state. Upon return of the equipment, the fuel tank will be refilled at customer expense. The customer reserves the right to utilize gas/diesel pumps other than those owned by the contractor. The cost of fuel (top off) where applicable will be included as a separate item on contractor's invoice and rental agreement.
- D. Routine fluid level checks will be made by the customer if the equipment is rented for any length of time. Checks will be made according to manufacturer's recommendation. Required fluids to include fuel, will be added at customer expense.
- E. Exterior washing of the equipment, prior to return, will be the responsibility of the customer.

9. Accidents or Repairs

In the event of an accident or if repairs become necessary, the customer will immediately notify the contractor and request a replacement unit. The time spent while waiting for a replacement unit shall be deducted from the total amount of equipment rental time the customer is charged. Accident costs will be determined based on completion of accident investigation.

Steps required:

- Step #2 **Attachment "C"** - Pricing Sheets; find Group, Class, and Item (they are sequential); determine Contractor (this is the first column on the price sheets) capable of furnishing needed equipment.
- Step #3 **Attachment "B"** - for supplier name, address, telephone no., and contact.
- Step #4 If item is available, proceed with rental requirement.
- Step #5 If item is not available, State Agency must comply with requirements of Item 9, or 10 Special Provisions above.

Change Notice No 5 published with company's name changed from Machinery Power & Equipment to NC-The CAT Rental Store.

- **07/17/06** : Contract Extension 01102-Equipment Rental (Construction Type) Contract appeared on the 150 day report for review. Contract folder pulled. Review of contract determined: Contract initial term due to expire 6/30/06. Contract contains clause for term extension (2 /2 year terms). This would be the 2nd possible extension. Contract contains clause for price adjustment. A search of the contract folder failed to uncover any unresolved issues or any complaints. Based on this review contract performance evaluation letters sent to agencies for review and evaluation. Contractor performance evaluation letters returned with the majority of agency reviews recommending that the contract be extended for another term. A few agency reviews express poor delivery and request some supplier be added to contract to eliminate this situation. Contract does not allow for suppliers to be added this must take place at rebid concerns noted. Preliminary review of the market place revealed that rental prices are escalating and a rebid at this time would impact pricing which could result in higher rental prices for state agencies at a time when budgets are reduced. Based on the above majority recommendations to extend contract for another term contractors were mailed contract extension letters for another two year term. Contract extension letters returned by 20 of 21 letters mailed suppliers with the following results 10 suppliers agreed to another term at current prices. 04 suppliers agree to another term extension but must have a price adjustment because of prices increase in materials and fuel. 06 suppliers did not agree to extend because they can not hold prices but would like to extend. 01 supplier had gone out of

equipment for the first term of contract. Suppliers deleted were: Feenaughty Machinery Co., Inc. and North West Handling Systems, Inc. All other contractors extended at current pricing. Extension will be posted to website July 1, 2004.
