NOTES REGARDING PERSONNEL:

1. Terms are payment due upon completion: if client desires 30 day credit add 3% to invoice.
2. Straight time 8:00am to 4:30 pm - Monday through Friday
3. Overtime: 4:30 pm to 8:00 am - Monday through Friday.
4. Premium time is charged for time worked on all weekends and federally recognized holidays.
5. Time charged to nearest 1/2 hour.
6. Emergency Response--minimum billing is 4 hours per job, per man. Minimum billing on holidays is 8 hours per job, per man. Remote job site work delays for reasons beyond ACT's control will be billed at an hourly rate per employee.
7. An additional sum per man hour is charged for time on jobs in Level A or B protection from time of suit up through decontamination to nearest 1/2 hour to cover costs of decontamination supplies and equipment. (Level A - \$10.00, Level B - \$5.00).
8. Subsistence and lodging will be charged at cost and will include a 20% administrative fee minimum of \$75.00 per day per man.
9. Personnel charges will include time spent on project-related travel, meetings, mobilization and demobilization, decontamination, cleaning and restocking equipment and supplies.

EQUIPMENT AND PERSONNEL RATE SCHEDULE FOR HAZARDOUS SPILL RESPONSE ACTIVITY

1. All equipment rates are “wet rates” which include operator, fuel, lube and related operating materials except as specified, and excludes delivery or pickup charges.
2. All rates, unless stated otherwise are based on a twenty-four hour day.
3. Protective clothing/foul weather gear (not chemical suits) will be charged at \$10.00 per man, per day.
4. Due to the nature of hazardous chemicals cleanup, it may be necessary to dispose of equipment and/or protective clothing due to contamination, corrosion or wear which may create additional charges which will be added to the invoice at cost with a 20% restocking fee.
5. When equipment security is required at off-site locations, the customer will have the option of providing adequate security or have our company provide security at the casual labor rate or hire a sub contractor security firm which will be charged at a cost with a 20% administrative fee.
6. Special billing rates will be provided as follows:
7. Additional pricing on heavy equipment and other unusual product and material that may be required on a hazardous waste spill cleanup or remediation site will be quoted specific to the site.
8. Rates for equipment used on contingency standby, long term rental or related purpose will be quoted upon request. Work performed is dependent upon and subject to the terms and conditions of our contract for environmental services or conditions of our contract for environmental services or applicable executed contract. Rates are subject to change without notice.
9. Service orders may be placed with our dispatch office which will be manned 24-hours per day including weekends and holidays.
10. Charges will commence from the time verbal or written authorization to proceed is received and will include transportation time of personnel and equipment to the job site.
11. Charges will terminate upon completion of operations, which will include transportation time of personnel and equipment back to the contractor’s operations center and demobilization of equipment.
12. Any additional equipment, supplies, or needed subcontractors will be charged at cost with a 20% administration fee added.
