

Listed below is the schedule where each member may see which pay period they may continue to work through, before retiring and being able to get their first pension payroll check processed on the next available cycle. Please note that if your first pension check is received more than a month later and you sign up for COBRA medical/dental, you will need to pay for the month in which you did not receive your 1st pension check. For example: If your last day of work is March 31, 2009, you will receive your 1st pension check on May 1, 2009, therefore you will need to pay the COBRA for the month of April.

If you choose to work past a "Last Day on Payroll" date, you will have to wait until the next cycle. For example, if your last day on payroll is April 30, 2009 (two days after April 28, 2009) your first pension check will not be received until July 1, 2009. Additionally, you may then be required to make two months of COBRA payments. Please plan accordingly.
