The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) is moving forward with construction of the North Beacon Safety Connections project.

You're invited to stop by an informal, community drop-in session to learn more about upcoming construction impacts that may start as early as October, 2014. The drop-in session will occur at the Beacon Hill Library, just prior to the September meeting of the North Beacon Hill Community Council (NBHCC).


Impacts & Schedule

Work is anticipated to begin as early as October and construction will last for approximately six months, with each site under construction for approximately 4 -9 weeks.

During construction, temporary traffic restrictions will be in place throughout the work areas. Pedestrian and bicycle access will be provided at all times. To allow crews to safely and efficiently construct the sidewalk on Beacon Avenue S, the westbound lanes of Beacon Avenue S will be closed to traffic during normal work hours (7 AM - 3 PM) for up to nine weeks.

Benefits

This project will help make it safer and easier for kids, neighbors and families to walk and bike in your neighborhood. The planned improvements will help reduce pedestrian crossing distances with the addition of curb bulbs in several locations, provide a continuous sidewalk on the east side of the street on Beacon Avenue S to connect the Mountains to Sound Trail with the Beacon Hill business district and reduce the amount of traffic on the non-arterial section of 14th Avenue S.
