

Construction Notice

Mercer Corridor Project Mercer East Construction

January 21, 2011

The following activities are scheduled to occur in the next few weeks:

Closure of Terry Ave. N from Valley St. to Mercer St.

What & Where: As previously announced, Terry Ave. N will be closed between Valley St. and Mercer St.

Why: Accommodates installation of upgraded utilities along the north side of Mercer St. and construction of new westbound Mercer St. lanes.

Closure Hours: Closed to through traffic 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The streetcar will continue to operate as usual on Terry Ave. N.

Duration: Several months, continuing if needed for construction activities.

Night Work at Broad St. and 9th Ave. N

What & Where: Westbound Broad St. will be reduced to one lane at the intersection of 9th Ave. N. Westbound traffic will be routed around the closure and will continue on Broad St.

Why: Installation of a temporary stormwater pipe needed for the sewer replacement.

Work Hours: Weeknight work, 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.


Duration: Approximately one week.

PSE Utility Work

Puget Sound Energy (PSE) is anticipated to begin independent utility work in the project area in early February, including nighttime work crossing Mercer St. at Boren Ave. N. This work is expected to take two weeks to complete. Questions about PSE work may be directed to Project Manager Tom Ling at 425-250-1544.

What to Expect During Construction:

- Night work including nighttime excavation
- Lane and road closures with appropriate traffic and bicycle detours
- Sidewalk closures and pedestrian detours
- Noise, dust, vibration and increased truck traffic
- Parking restrictions



Current road closures and upcoming construction activities scheduled to occur in the next few weeks.

What's Next?

The following activities are scheduled in January and February:

- Continue side sewer excavations on 9th Ave. N
- Complete excavation of sewer replacement access pit on 9th Ave. N south of Broad St.
- Begin operation of temporary sewer bypass
- Begin installation of new 30-inch sewer line; crews will begin pipe reaming on 9th Ave. N between Aloha St. and Republican St.

Please note all schedules are dependent on weather conditions and availability of materials.
