Mercer Corridor Project Mercer East Construction

July 22-25: Concurrent closure of Broad St. and I-5 on- and off-ramp closure at Mercer St.

While the I-5 on- and off-ramps at Mercer St. are closed over the July 22 – 25 weekend, crews will take advantage of anticipated reduced traffic volumes on Broad St. to work in the intersection of Broad St. and 9th Ave. N for required storm drainage installations.

This closure has been coordinated for when much of Broad St. traffic (travelers exiting I-5 onto Valley St./Broad St.) will be routed to other areas due to the weekend closure of the Mercer St. ramps.

What & Where: Westbound Broad St. closed between Westlake Ave. N and 9th Ave. N.

Detour Routes: Travelers heading west on Valley St. toward Broad St. will be detoured on southbound Westlake Ave. N to Denny Way for access to the Seattle Center and downtown Seattle or northbound on Westlake Ave. N to 8th Ave. N for access to lower Queen Anne and Dexter Ave. N.

Why: Installation of storm drainage utilities in the intersection of Broad St. and 9th Ave. N.

Work Hours: Closure will occur from Friday at 11:00 p.m. to Monday at 5:00 a.m. Crews may work up to 24-hours a day if required.
