

# CONSTRUCTION NOTICE – Please read carefully

Your street will be closed to traffic, including bicycles, for 4 to 6 hours according to the schedule on the back of this notice. All work will be completed between 7 AM and 5 PM.

Dear Neighbor,

July 2016

Crews working for SDOT will soon apply a microsurfacing overlay to your street. This will require your street to be closed between the hours of 7 AM and 5 PM on the date shown for your street on the map on the back of this notice. Microsurfacing is a street maintenance technique and consists of asphalt emulsion and aggregate that will require 4 to 6 hours to apply, dry, and be ready for traffic. If driven on or walked through before they dry, microsurfacing materials can stain your car, carpets, or floors.

We realize the inconvenience this creates and appreciate your patience. **Our intention is to protect the roadway and personal property during this work.**

## Actions for residents

- Please follow posted “No Parking” signs and detours. Cars parked within the posted work area will be towed away at the owner’s expense.
- If you wish to use your car on the day you are scheduled for microsurfacing, we recommend you move it to a street not scheduled for work before 7 AM. Please remove other personal items such as flower pots and outdoor furniture from the road.
- Please do not wash cars or water lawns the day before or during the work. Microsurfacing is less effective on a wet road.
- If it is your normal garbage, recycling, or yard waste day, please have bins to the curb by 6 AM to ensure pick-up. We will not affect pick-up.
- For their own safety, please keep children and animals away from the area while work is in progress.

## What to expect

- Please keep in mind that once we have microsurfaced your street, you will not be able to use the street until it reopens to traffic.
- Emergency vehicles will have access to all streets at all times.
- If we are unable to maintain our daily schedule, you will be re-notified of the new date to microsurface your street.
