After further examination of the road, the contractor has determined they need to use a smaller truck to safely microsurface your street. We need to postpone this work until the smaller truck arrives because the street is too narrow and winding for their larger truck. **Your street will *not* be closed Thursday, July 28.**

We will follow up with you when we know more about the new date to microsurface your street. To be notified of the new date as soon as it is confirmed, we encourage you to share your contact information with us by calling 206-727-3669 (voicemail) or emailing 2016Microsurfacing@seattle.gov. Two to three days before the work begins, we will distribute a flyer with the new closure date and post “No Parking” signs on your street again. If you have questions, please contact us. I apologize for this inconvenience and thank you for your understanding.
