

FAIRVIEW AVE E INTERSECTION & PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS

ROAD CLOSURE NOW RE-SCHEDULED FOR AUGUST 6 –24

Fairview Ave E to be closed at Fairview Ave N

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) is constructing a new sidewalk and making other pedestrian improvements on Fairview Ave E. Work began on July 17 and is expected to be completed by mid- September, weather permitting.

The contractor expects to close Fairview Ave E at Fairview Ave N between August 6th and August 24th although closure dates may shift. Fairview Ave N will remain open throughout this period and Fairview Ave E will remain accessible from E Garfield Street and E Blaine Street.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

As part of the Cheshiahud Lake Union Loop, the project will build a 6 foot asphalt walkway along the waterside of Fairview Ave E and connect to the existing asphalt walkway at E Blaine Street.

Fairview Ave E and Fairview Ave N:

- Reducing the southbound lane width of Fairview Ave N
- Adding on-street parking to Fairview Ave N in the project area
- Adding bicycle facilities along Fairview Ave N

What to Expect During Construction:

- **Typical work hours 7 am to 6 pm; Mon-Fri**
- **Parking and loading restrictions in project area**
- **Selective tree and vegetation removal**
- **Traffic and pedestrian detours – Fairview Ave E closed at Fairview Ave N, August 6-24**
- **Moderate construction noise and dust**
