

NE 125th Street / Sand Point Way NE Paving Project

What You Can Expect During Construction

- Most work on weekdays between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- Occasional nighttime work between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Increased travel times through the construction zone
- Temporary bus stop relocations or closures
- Parking restrictions near work zones
- Short-term driveway closures and sidewalk detours
- Moderate levels of noise, dust and/or mud, particularly in areas of road base repair
- South-bound detours on Sand Point Way (east of 35th Avenue NE) and one lane of north-bound traffic around the active work zone
- Full closure of NE 125th Street and Lake City Way NE Intersection for two nights
- Full closure of the NE 130th Street exit from I-5 for two nights

Traffic Restrictions During Construction

NE 125th Street west of 35th Avenue NE and Roosevelt Way NE are wide enough to allow two-way traffic during construction. NE 125th Street east of 35th Avenue NE and nearly all of Sand Point Way NE are too narrow for two-way traffic to safely pass around some of the planned work zones. In these areas, southbound traffic will be detoured or one way traffic flows will be controlled by flaggers depending on the nature of the work occurring.

When a detour is in effect, southbound Metro stops will be closed. Timing and duration of the detours and related stop closures will be determined in conjunction with Metro as construction progresses.
