BACKGROUND

S Lander St is an essential east-west corridor in Seattle's SODO neighborhood. Every day, S Lander St serves freight, commuters, pedestrians, and bicyclists, as well as King County Metro buses and the Port of Seattle.

S Lander St includes a crossing of four railroad tracks, which carry freight, Amtrak, and Sounder trains. Vehicle and rail operations at these tracks are a safety risk and cause traffic delays.


To improve traffic, freight, and safety, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will build a bridge over S Lander St between 1st Ave S and 4th Ave S. This project is now moving forward after being on hold for several years, and SDOT is currently revisiting the overall project design to ensure the safest and most effective solution.
