

## Westlake Cycle Track Community Roundtables - **DRAFT**

### Decision Requested

Does the Westlake Cycle Track Design Advisory Committee (DAC) believe there is utility to SDOT hosting problem solving and information gathering roundtables along the corridor? Do they think the input gathered would be helpful in informing their feedback process?

### Overview

The DAC is charged with providing SDOT feedback during design of a cycle track within the Westlake Avenue North right-of-way. The DAC is comprised of stakeholders representing various interests.

To supplement the DAC's input, SDOT proposes up to three community roundtables to review specific design considerations at key locations and help problem solve. At these roundtables, SDOT staff, a member of Toole Design Group, and community stakeholders would focus on key locations where there are challenges or opportunities and discuss potential solutions the construction of a bike facility could provide.

### Staffing

Each meeting would be staffed by representatives from the following:

- Seattle Department of Transportation
- Department of Planning and Design as needed
- Office of Economic Development as needed
- Toole Design
- EnviroIssues

### Expected attendees

Each meeting would be planned to accommodate up to 20 attendees, comprised of the following stakeholder groups:

- Interested DAC members
- Area homes and businesses
- Bike/ped organizations
- General public as they're interested

### Community partners/roundtable hosting

The project team would identify and reach out to engaged community members with a request to help host the roundtable events. Based on the topic or location, they could recommend roundtable participants and a venue. AGC has expressed an interest in participating in these roundtables.

**Timing**

The roundtables would be hosted in the corridor between DAC meeting 4 on June 23 and DAC meeting 5 on July 28 (July 14 is currently noted as TBD). The roundtables could be hosted weeks of July 7 or July 14, pending staff, stakeholder and venue availability.

**Options for locations**

The roundtable discussions could be focused by segments, **or** focused on a couple of key areas to help resolve specific challenges.
