

Stairway Improvements Near NW 95th Street

Project Description

Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) crews will finish replacing the stairway on NW 95th Street between 24th Avenue NW and 25th Avenue NW starting in late May. The upper staircase and landings will be replaced – similar to the lower flight of stairs that was completed last summer. Additionally, a retaining wall will be constructed adjacent to the new staircase. Construction is expected to last approximately 6-8 weeks.

This project is part of SDOT's program to restore stairways throughout the city to improve safety and accessibility. It is funded by the voter-approved Bridging the Gap transportation levy.



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Full closure of stairway until project completion (unless otherwise indicated)
- Typical work hours from 7 AM to 3 PM
- Noise from heavy machinery and trucks
- Pedestrian detour along 24th Avenue NW and 25th Avenue NW (see map)
