Central Area Neighborhood Greenway Residential Street Access Restrictions

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) is installing a rectangular rapid flashing beacon at the intersection of 25th Avenue and E Cherry Street for the Central Area Neighborhood Greenway Project. In order to complete this work, access to 25th Avenue will be temporarily restricted around the clock from 7 AM on Monday, June 1 until 5 PM on Friday, June 5, 2015.

Limited Road Access

On Monday, June 1, crews will close access to 25th Avenue from E Cherry Street. Drivers will be detoured using eastbound E Cherry Street, southbound 26th Avenue, and westbound E Jefferson Street. During this time, local access on northbound 25th Avenue south of E Cherry Street will be maintained, but access to E Cherry Street from 25th Avenue will be restricted.

Project Information

Phase 1 of the Central Area Neighborhood Greenway runs between East John Street and South Jackson Street on residential streets parallel to 23rd Avenue, including stretches of 25th Avenue, 22nd Avenue, and 21st Avenue East.


Elements include curb ramps, bicycle pavement markings on the route, stop signs on streets crossing the greenway, and approximately one speed hump per block. A flashing beacon for pedestrians and bicycles has already been installed at 25th Avenue and East Yesler Way, and an enhanced pedestrian signal will soon be installed at 22nd Avenue and East Union Street. These signals will be activated when Phase 1 is complete at the end of July.

- Reduce speeds
- Use caution
- Keep a safe distance from construction

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING GREENWAY INSTALLATION

- Normal work hours will be from 7 AM to 4 PM
- Temporary on-street parking restrictions
- Temporary access restrictions on residential streets
- Pedestrian and bicycle detours
- Light construction noise
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained except when temporary restrictions are necessary
