

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

JUNE 23, 2015

23rd Avenue Corridor Improvements Project

Overnight intersection work planned for June 27-29

Starting 9 AM on Saturday, June 27, through 4 AM on Monday, June 29, access to the intersection of S Jackson Street and 23rd Avenue S will be closed to traffic. This closure is necessary so that crews complete utility work under the street.

Work hours

- Continuous work between **9 AM, Saturday, June 27 and 4 AM, Monday, June 29**
- Neighbors can expect noise, dust and vibration throughout this work
- The City of Seattle has approved a temporary noise variance to perform this work

Water interruptions

- Seattle Public Utilities will provide notice to businesses and residents who will experience temporary water shut-offs while crews connect the new water main
- Water shut-offs for some customers are scheduled to begin at 10 PM on Saturday, June 27 and last until 7 AM on Sunday, June 28

Traffic impacts

- The intersection will be completely closed to traffic
- Detour routes will be clearly posted; please follow signed detours and avoid cutting through neighborhood streets
- Local access to residents and businesses will be provided
- The northbound 23rd Avenue detour to Martin Luther King Jr Way will remain in place

Transit, bicycle and pedestrian info

- Metro bus routes westbound #14 and southbound #48 will be affected by this work; look for posted Rider Alerts and learn more by calling Metro at 206-553-3000
- Westbound bicyclists should also detour around the intersection during this work
- Pedestrian crossings will be maintained
- Flaggers and uniformed police officers will be present to assist pedestrians and manage traffic
