

Construction at W Harrison Street and 1st Avenue W and 2nd Avenue W to start as soon as August 3

Crews working for the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will begin constructing pedestrian safety improvements at the intersections of W Harrison Street and 1st Avenue W and 2nd Avenue W as soon as **Monday, August 3**. Construction is expected to last approximately 6 weeks, weather dependent.

Temporary lane restrictions and road closures

As soon as August 3rd, crews will temporarily close the north side of the 2nd Avenue W and W Harrison Street intersection and the south side of the intersection of 1st Avenue W and W Harrison Street. The closures will be in place 24-hours a day and are expected to last for the first 3 weeks of construction.


For the last 3 weeks of construction, crews will temporarily close the south side of the 2nd Avenue W and W Harrison Street intersection and the north side of the 1st Avenue W and W Harrison Street intersection.

W Harrison Street between Queen Anne Avenue N and 3rd Avenue W will be restricted to a single lane during work hours throughout the duration of the project. Two-way traffic will be preserved and a flagger will direct traffic. On-street parking will be restricted on W Harrison Street between Queen Anne Avenue N and 3rd Avenue W and where 1st and 2nd Avenues intersect W Harrison Street.

These closures allow crews to safely and efficiently construct the curb extensions, repair concrete panels, install drainage inlets and re-paint the crosswalks at each intersection. Local access will be maintained at all times. SDOT encourages northbound traffic to use 3rd Avenue W and southbound traffic to use Queen Anne Avenue N. People walking and biking will be routed around the closures.

Outreach during construction

The project team will post no-parking signs and notify properties of any driveway closures and construction impacts. WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Short-term parking and lane restrictions on 1st Ave W, 2nd Ave W and W Harrison St
- Temporary road closures at the intersections of 1st and 2nd Ave W at W Harrison St; pedestrians will be routed around work – please follow posted detours
- Noise, dust and vibration
- Typical weekday work hours, 7 AM to 5 PM
