

CENTRAL AREA NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAY

Phase 1 is complete!

Phase 1 of the Central Area Neighborhood Greenway was completed in September 2015. People walking and biking may now enjoy:

- Bicycle pavement markings on the route
- Stop signs on all streets crossing the greenway
- Flashing beacons for pedestrians and bicycles at arterial crossings: 25th Ave. S. and E. Yesler Way; 25th Ave. S. and E. Cherry St.
- Enhanced pedestrian traffic signal at 22nd Ave. E. and E. Union Street
- Approximately one speed hump per block on the route



Phase 2 and 3 construction

With phase 1 now complete, installation of phases 2 and 3 (at the north and south ends of the greenway, respectively) will begin this fall.

Elements of phases 2 and 3 include:


- Bicycle pavement markings on the route
- Stop signs on all streets crossing the greenway
- Flashing beacons for pedestrians and bicycles at arterial crossings:
 - E Howe Street and Boyer Avenue E
 - 21st Avenue E and E Aloha Street
 - 25th Avenue S and S Jackson Street
 - 25th Avenue S and S Massachusetts Street
- A protected bike lane on Boyer Avenue E from Interlaken Park to 23rd Avenue E
- Approximately one speed hump per block on the route

Greenway route

The route for Central Area Neighborhood Greenway, which when complete will run on residential streets adjacent to 23rd Ave. between E Roanoke St. on the north and Rainier Ave. S. on the south, was selected with the help of extensive community input gathered at open houses, drop-in sessions, presentations, and briefings.

A greenway is a residential street made safer and more comfortable for people of all ages and abilities to walk and ride bikes. Neighborhood greenways start with a good foundation and make small improvements that add up to a big difference.

All phases of the the Central Area Neighborhood Greenway will be complete by the end of 2015.
