

## Construction on 12th Ave at E Howell and E Olive streets will begin as soon as September 28

Crews working for the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will begin work on safety improvements at the intersections of 12th Ave with E Howell and E Olive streets as soon as **September 28**. We expect construction will last approximately 6 weeks, weather dependent.

This work will require the temporary closure of E Howell and E Olive streets to all traffic at 12th Ave, 24-hours a day throughout the project. Bike lanes on 12th Ave between E Pine St and E Denny Way will also be temporarily closed. People riding bikes will be directed to merge with vehicle traffic.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Parking and lane restrictions on 12th Ave between E Pine St and E Denny Way. A flagger will be present to maintain two-way traffic.
- Temporary closure of E Howell and E Olive streets at 12th Ave. Local access will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian detours around the work areas at the corners of 12th Ave and E Howell and E Olive streets.
- Temporary closure of USPS collection box at the corner of 12th Ave and E Howell St.
- Noise, dust, and vibration.
- Weekday work hours, 7 AM to 5 PM.

El equipo del Seattle Department of Transportation iniciará obras para mejorar la seguridad de los peatones sobre 12th Ave, en las calles E Howell e E Olive, alrededor del día lunes 28 de septiembre. Se espera que este proyecto dure seis semanas, dependiendo del clima.

Las obras afectarán a las personas que conducen, caminan o andan en bicicleta por esta zona:

- Habrá una restricción temporal de estacionamiento y carriles de tránsito en 12th Ave, E Howell y E Olive.
- También, E Howell e E Olive estarán cerradas temporalmente a la altura de 12th Ave.
- Habrá desviaciones alrededor de las obras: ¡por favor haga caso a las señales de "Desviación"!

El proyecto tiene como fin añadir mejoras a la seguridad de los peatones en estas dos intersecciones, lo cual incluirá extensiones en la guarnición de las aceras que reducirán la distancia de los cruces peatonales y ayudarán a los conductores a ver a las personas que esperan para cruzar la calle.
