Central Area Neighborhood Greenway Lane Restrictions Begin November 5

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will construct new curb ramps and pour new sidewalks at the intersection of 24th Ave and S Irving St beginning Thursday, November 5, 2015. Weather permitting, work in the area is expected to be complete by the end of the following week, Friday, November 13.

This work is part of SDOT's Central Area Neighborhood Greenway Project.

Intermittent Lane Closures

During construction, flaggers will be stationed at 24th Ave and S Irving St from 7 AM to 4 PM, Monday through Friday, to direct traffic.

Project Information

Earlier this year, SDOT installed Phase 1 of the Central Area Neighborhood Greenway, which runs on residential streets parallel to 23rd Ave between S Jackson St and E John St. Phase 2 of the greenway runs between S Hill St and S Jackson St, primarily on 24th Avenue S, 25th Avenue S, and 26th Avenue S.

In addition to new curb ramps, elements include pedestrian/bicycle flashing beacons, bicycle pavement markings on the route, stop signs on streets crossing the greenway, and approximately one speed hump per block.


Phase 2 will be complete by spring 2016.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING GREENWAY INSTALLATION

- Normal work hours will be from 7 AM to 4 PM
- Temporary on-street parking restrictions
- Pedestrian and bicycle detours
- Light construction noise
- Access to residences will be maintained except when temporary restrictions are necessary
- Phases 2 installation will be complete by spring 2016
