

Delridge-Highland Park Neighborhood Greenway Construction at 17th Ave SW cul-de-sac begins December 16

Beginning as early as December 16, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will begin constructing a pedestrian pathway connecting areas north and south of the cul-de-sac on 17th Ave SW between SW Myrtle and SW Webster streets. This work is part of the Delridge-Highland Park Neighborhood Greenway Project and will take approximately 2 weeks to complete.

Traffic, parking and pedestrian impacts during construction:


- Signage will be placed at the south side of 17th Ave SW and SW Myrtle St to alert travelers of roadwork ahead.
- Signage will be placed at the north side of 17th Ave SW and SW Webster St to alert travelers of roadwork ahead.
- Parking may be limited in the work area.
- Pedestrian detours will be in place around the work area.

Improvements to be made at the cul-de-sac on 17th Ave SW between SW Myrtle and SW Webster streets include:

- New cement pedestrian pathway connecting areas north and south of the cul-de-sac
- New permanent retaining curb
- New curb ramps at the north and south entrance of pedestrian pathway
- Newly installed bike sharrows

Project Information

Greenways are residential streets made safer and more comfortable for people of all ages and abilities to walk and ride bikes. This work is part of the Delridge-Highland Park Greenway project that will connect White Center to the West Seattle Bridge Trail. The greenway will run north-south, generally along 17th Avenue SW in the south and 21st Avenue SW in the north.



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Weekday work hours of 7 AM to 7 PM
- Traffic and parking restrictions
- Street closed, local access maintained
- Typical construction noise

This work is weather dependent and may be rescheduled if needed.
