CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE AND IMPACTS

We expect construction will be complete in late August, weather permitting. No work is planned for nights, weekends, or major holidays. We will maintain access to residences.

Parking restrictions


- Parking on a portion of E Mercer St will be restricted throughout construction
- Parking on a portion of 24th Ave E will be restricted for approximately one week

Sidewalk impacts

- People using the north sidewalk on E Mercer St between 23rd and 24th Ave E will be detoured to the south side of E Mercer St
- People using the west sidewalk on 24th Ave E between E Roy and E Mercer streets will be detoured to the east side of 24th Ave E

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- The stairway will include new handrails on each side, with a second handrail at a lower height to accommodate both adults and children
- The reconstructed retaining wall meets seismic standards and is designed for a 75-year life
- Planting strips will be restored and trees will be planted in early fall



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Daytime construction activities between 7 AM and 6 PM, Mon - Fri
- Noisy work, including jack hammering and backup alarms required for safety
- Construction equipment such as a drilling rig, excavator, dump trucks, and concrete pump trucks
