

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE – Please read carefully

Your street or streets in your area will be closed to traffic, including bicycles, for 4 to 6 hours according to the schedule on the reverse. All work will be completed between 7 AM and 5 PM.

Dear Neighbor,

August 2016

Crews working for SDOT will soon apply a microsurfacing overlay to Everett Ave E in Montlake. This will require closing Everett Ave E between 7 AM and 5 PM on Friday, August 19. Microsurfacing is a street maintenance technique involving asphalt emulsion and aggregate that requires 4 to 6 hours to apply, dry, and be ready for traffic. If driven on or walked through before dry, microsurfacing materials can stain your car, carpets, or floors.

We realize the inconvenience this creates and appreciate your patience. **Our intention is to protect the roadway and personal property during this work.**

Actions for residents and businesses

- Please follow posted "No Parking" signs and detours. Cars parked within the posted work area will be towed away at the owner's expense.
- If you wish to use your car on the day you are scheduled for microsurfacing, we recommend you move it to a street not scheduled for work before 7 AM. Crews will alternate street closures to maintain access to and from the area.
- Please remove other personal items such as flower pots or outdoor furniture from the road.
- For their own safety, please keep children and animals away from the area while work is in progress.
- If it is your normal garbage, recycling, or yard waste day, please have bins to the curb by 6 AM on the day of the work to ensure pick-up. We will not affect pickup.
- Please do not wash cars or water lawns the day before or during the work. Microsurfacing is less effective on a wet road.

What to expect

- Please keep in mind that once a street is microsurfaced, you will not be able to use it until it reopens.
- Emergency vehicles will have access to streets at all times.
- If we are unable to maintain our daily schedule, you will be re-notified of the new date to microsurface your street.
