



23rd Avenue Corridor Improvements Project

E Yesler Way partial intersection closures: Weekdays from February 15 – 22

The 23rd Ave and E Yesler Way intersection will be partially closed to through traffic on weekdays from February 15 - February 22 for paving and electrical work. Southbound traffic on 23rd Ave will be maintained, but eastbound and westbound traffic on E Yesler Way will be detoured. The intersection will be opened to eastbound and westbound traffic over the weekend of February 20. The paving work is weather dependent and may be rescheduled.

Work dates

- Crews will work at the 23rd Ave and E Yesler Way intersection on weekdays from Monday, February 15 to Monday, February 22
- Crews anticipate to work from 7 AM to 3 PM each weekday; however, the intersection configuration will remain in place overnight

Construction impacts

- Neighbors should expect noise, dust, and vibration during work hours

Transit, bicycle, and pedestrian information

- Metro bus route 27 and its bus stops will be affected by this work; look for posted Rider Alerts and learn more by calling Metro at 206-553-3000
- Bicyclists should detour around the intersection during this work
- Pedestrian crossings will be maintained

Traffic impacts

- The 23rd Ave and E Yesler Way intersection will be closed to eastbound and westbound traffic for 6 days:
 - **February 15, 16, and 22:** Crews will work on the east side of the intersection
 - **February 17 – 19:** Crews will work on the west side of the intersection
- 23rd Ave will remain open to southbound traffic at all times
- The intersection will be open to eastbound and westbound traffic the weekend of February 20
- The northbound 23rd Ave detour to Martin Luther King Jr Way will remain in place
- Detour routes will be clearly posted; follow the signed detours and avoid cutting through neighborhood streets

In March, crews will reopen 23rd Ave S between S Jackson St and E Yesler Way to two-way traffic.


