

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE – Please read carefully

Your street or a street near you will be closed to traffic, including bicycles, for 4 to 6 hours according to the schedules on the reverse. All work will be completed between 7 AM and 5 PM.

Dear Neighbor,

August 2016

Crews working for SDOT will soon apply a microsurfacing overlay to streets in your area. This will require your street or streets near you to be closed between 7 AM and 5 PM according to the map schedules shown on the reverse. Microsurfacing is a street maintenance technique and consists of asphalt emulsion and aggregate that will require 4 to 6 hours to apply, dry, and be ready to drive, bike, or walk on. If driven on or walked through before it's dry, microsurfacing materials can stain your car, carpets, or floors.

Please note: In South Wallingford, we will not microsurface Burke Ave N between N 34th St and N 35th St because an unrelated project needs to complete pavement restoration and other, related work first. Additionally, in South Wallingford, we will not microsurface across the Burke-Gilman Trail. However, we will microsurface portions of the Burke-Gilman Trail in Southeast Ballard. See information below.

We realize the inconvenience this creates and appreciate your patience. Our intention is to protect the street and personal property during this work.

Actions for residents and businesses

- Please follow posted "No Parking" signs and detours. Cars parked within the posted work area will be towed away at the owner's expense. In Southeast Ballard, people biking on the Burke-Gilman Trail will be re-routed to Leary Way NW and NW 46th St. Please follow posted signage.
- If you wish to use your car on the day you are scheduled for microsurfacing, we recommend you move it to a street not scheduled for work before 7 AM. Crews will sequence work to maintain access to and from parking lots and garages when feasible.
- Please remove other personal items such as flower pots or outdoor furniture from the road.
- For their own safety, please keep children and animals away from the area while work is in progress.
- If it is your normal garbage, recycling, or yard waste day, please have bins to the curb by 6 AM on the day of the work to ensure pick-up. We will not affect pick-up.
- Please do not wash cars or water lawns the day before or during the work. Microsurfacing is less effective on a wet road.

What to expect

- Please keep in mind that once a street is microsurfaced, you will not be able to use it until it reopens.
- Although the Burke-Gilman Trail will not be microsurfaced, large equipment will be located near the trail in the vicinity of Gas Works Park. Bicyclists should exercise caution when passing the equipment.
- Emergency vehicles will have access to streets at all times.
- If we are unable to maintain our daily schedule, you will be re-notified of the new date to microsurface your street.


