



23rd Avenue Corridor Improvements Project

Paving work at the E Union St intersection October 7 – 9

The intersection of 23rd Ave and E Union St will be closed October 7 to October 9 for crews to complete roadway demolition and paving work. Local access to businesses, community destinations, and residences near the intersection will be provided, but through traffic will be detoured. Starting Saturday at 7 PM, southbound 23rd Ave traffic will be allowed through the intersection, but east and west traffic will remain detoured until Sunday morning. **This schedule is weather dependent and subject to change.**

Work details

- Crews plan to work continuously from 7 PM on Friday, October 7 to 10 AM on Sunday, October 9
- This schedule is weather dependent and subject to change; please visit the project website (address below) for the latest schedule
- Additional E Union St intersection closures may be required

Traffic impacts

- The 23rd Ave and E Union St intersection will be completely closed to through traffic starting 7 PM on Friday, October 7
- Crews will reopen the intersection to southbound traffic at 7 PM on Saturday, October 8; the remaining directions of travel will be reopened at the completion of work at 10 AM on Sunday, October 9
- Crews will provide local access to destinations at the intersection
- Detour routes will be clearly posted; please follow the signed detours and avoid cutting through neighborhood streets

Construction impacts


- Neighbors should expect noise, dust, and vibration throughout all hours of the weekend
- The contractor is obtaining a noise variance for this work
- The noisiest work (breaking pavement, sawcutting, jackhammers) is prohibited between 11 PM and 7 AM

Transit, bicycle, and pedestrian information

- King County Metro routes 2 and 48 will run as normal until the end of service Friday night, but buses will be detoured on Saturday and Sunday; call 206-553-3000 or visit <http://metro.kingcounty.gov/alerts/>
- Bicyclists should also detour around the intersection
- Pedestrian crossings will be maintained

- Customers can continue to access businesses on foot or by driving into the local access areas

UPCOMING E JOHN ST WORK


- Crews plan to work at 23rd Ave and E John St October 15 – 16 and 22 – 23
