23rd Avenue Corridor Improvements Project

Upcoming weekend closures planned for the E John St intersection

The intersection of 23rd Ave E and E John St will be closed for up to 2 weekends in October (October 15 – 16 and 22 – 23) for crews to complete work as part of the 23rd Avenue Corridor Improvements Project. These closures are necessary for crews to install the foundations for new trolley poles at the intersection while the overhead trolley wires are not electrified. The contractor will provide local access to businesses, community destinations, and residences near the intersection, but through traffic will be detoured from 7 AM to 7 PM. This schedule is subject to change.

Work dates

- **Crews plan to work from 7 AM to 7 PM on these dates:**
 - Saturday, October 15 and Sunday, October 16
 - Saturday, October 22 and Sunday, October 23
- This schedule is weather dependent and subject to change; please visit the project website (address below) for the latest schedule and to sign up for regular project email updates

Traffic impacts

- The 23rd Ave E and E John St intersection will be completely closed to through traffic (including buses) from 7 AM to 7 PM on the dates above, with detours via E Aloha St, 19th Ave E, and E Madison St (see map)
- Parking on E Aloha St will be restricted from 19th Ave E to 23rd Ave E during this work to allow space for buses
- Crews will provide access to destinations near the intersection
- Detour routes will be clearly posted; please follow the signed detours and avoid cutting through neighborhood streets

Transit, bicycle, and pedestrian information


- King County Metro routes 8, 43, 48, 980, and 988 and their bus stops will be detoured around the intersection during this work; look for posted Rider Alerts, call Metro at 206-553-3000, or visit metro.kingcounty.gov/signup/ for details
- Bicyclists should also detour around the intersection
- Pedestrian crossings will be maintained

Construction impacts

- Expect noise, dust, and vibration at the intersection
- No overnight work currently planned

- Customers can continue to access businesses and community destinations on foot or by driving into the local access areas

- The purpose of the 23rd Avenue Corridor Improvements Project is to improve safety and mobility for people who drive, walk, bike, and take transit
- Construction for Phase 1 of the project, from S Jackson St to E John St, started in June 2015 and is expected to be complete by early 2017


