

## 23rd Avenue Corridor Improvements Project

### Overnight intersection work planned for June 19-20

Starting 8 PM on Friday, June 19, through 6 AM on Saturday, June 20, access to westbound S Jackson Street will be closed to traffic at the intersection of S Jackson Street and 23rd Avenue S. This closure is necessary so that crews can test the new water main under the street.

### Night work details


- Continuous work between 8 PM Friday, June 19, and 6 AM, Saturday, June 20
- Neighbors can expect noise, dust and vibration throughout this work
- The City of Seattle has approved a temporary noise variance to perform this work
- No planned utility interruptions

### Traffic changes

- Longer travel times and delays
- Access to westbound S Jackson Street will be closed to traffic
- Detour routes will be clearly posted; please follow signed detours and avoid cutting through neighborhood streets (see map on back)
- Northbound 23rd Avenue will remain closed and detoured to Martin Luther King Jr Way

### Transit, bicycles and pedestrians

- No impacts to Metro route #14 or southbound route #48
  - Look for posted Rider Alerts and learn more by calling Metro at 206-553-3000
- Westbound bicyclists should also detour around the intersection during this work
- Pedestrian crossings will be maintained
- Flaggers and uniformed police officers will be present to assist pedestrians and manage traffic



- Northbound closed: work zone
- Northbound detour route

**June 19-20 Work Detour**

- Westbound Jackson St closure detour
- Local access only
